Shared Device & Feature Restricted License

Substance 3D apps are currently available to Shared Device & Feature Restricted license Creative Cloud All Apps plans in Higher Education:

- All SDL and FRL customers have access as of July 28th, 2021
- Admin will need to [repackage](#) and deploy Substance 3D Painter, Designer, Stager, and Sampler apps in order for users to access via lab devices

Named User License

All VIP Named User customers, including Student License Pack, now have access to Substance 3D Apps

- Once users have access to Substance 3D Apps access, they should download Substance 3D Painter, Designer, Stager, and Sampler apps through Creative Cloud Desktop App
- IT admin can also [create packages](#) on the Adobe Admin Console for the Adobe apps and services that you want to distribute to your end users.

Hardware Requirements

3D software in particular can require your computer to make an enormous number of calculations each second — so the higher the performance of your computer, the smoother and more hassle-free your 3D experience will be overall. With these [hardware recommendations](#), even with Named User access, lab environments, rather than personal machines, may still provide

the most optimal performance for many students using Substance 3D apps.
